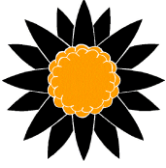

### How to apply

A one page letter of intent from the prospective researcher should include the following:

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- The researcher's name and telephone number
- The kind of research to be conducted (what you desire to do)
- The process for conducting the research
- Time frames for conducting the research
- Brief explanation identifying why the researcher desires to use the PRP
- A description of the ways in which the research will benefit the community
