1. Submit a one page letter of intent to by e-mail to Peter Lichtenberg <p.lichtenberg@wayne.edu>, including:
 - Your name and telephone number
 - The kind of research to be conducted (what you desire to do)
 - The process for conducting the research
 - Time frames for conducting the research
 - Brief explanation identifying why the researcher desires to use the PRP
 - A description of the ways in which the research will benefit the community
